

Aspects of identity which were included in the models (extended version of Table 8.1)

For the purposes of this table, I sought to group together the different aspects of identity that people had represented in their Lego models. Nevertheless, a total of 128 different aspects of identity were presented. In the book, only the top 16 are listed in Table 8.1, because much of the list is a 'long tail' of aspects which each appeared in only a small number of models. But, for the curious, here is the full table.
